MEMBERS TRAINING:

On the month of June our brother Artemio Benavidez, his wife Rocio Rosas and Carmen Alcala started their training at the seminary of our Regional Convention. It will take them a year and a half to complete their training for ministry.



Eight individuals started and completed the discipleship training using Experiencing God they will continue to be disciple and train.

By the end of the month of July we started disciplining four individuals and preparing them for baptism. Baptisms are schedule for the month of September.

On June forth, a group of our young adults participated on a workshop title "Kinds Games" which purpose was to train and prepared them for Vacation Bible School and the Pan-American games.

NEW LOCATIONS:



We are thankful to God that we have been able to start work in the neighborhood of Los Agaves. We have been renting a house in which we held services on Tuesdays and Sundays. We continue to contact and reach out the community, up to date 10 families that have participated with us.

We are supporting Brother Manuel Magallanes' ministry. He is reaching out to individuals who have been imprisoned and their families. The meetings are held at a facility located in downtown.



VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL:

We were greatly blessed by having among us the mission team which was coordinated by Judith Gonzalez and Julie Humphrey. They participated during our Vacation Bible School the first week of July.

During VBS we worked in the mornings at Las Pintitas and in the early evenings at different locations where we have small groups. We had an average of 100 children in Las Pintitas and 50 during the early evenings.

We were able to make a lot of contacts and there were 18 children that made professions of faith 6 adults.

PAN-AMERICAN GAMES:

The coordination of events for the Pan-American games is well on its way. We are actively planning the evangelistic efforts and we are seeking to involve the majority of the churches that are part of the Regional Convention as well as members of the National Convention. We are also seeking participation from conventions from the United State and Latin America.



We are excited to share that God has provided for all the materials that we need and we are ready to work.

SPECIAL EVENTS:

On July $17^{\rm th}$ we assisted and supported the members of the Martinica, which church flooded. We encourage them in prayer and provided materials and other items that they needed to carry out their Vacation Bible School.





We have participated in join worship services, the celebration of church anniversaries, youth and young adults meetings, and Pan-American's preparation meetings. This has allowed us to have fellowship with other congregations.

EVANGELISTIC EVENTS:

On June 11th we organized an Evangelistic Outreach for Children, in La Plaza de Campos in the state of Colima, in which we had an average of 150 individuals participating.

We also had puppet ministry training for members of the church in that city.



The 25 of June the church JESUCRISTO ES EL SEÑOR supported an outreach event at Las Pintitas, participating with their traditional Rondalla Band and lead worship.

On August $27^{\rm th}$ we had an evangelistic campaign at the plaza at Las Pintitas, our worship team participated.
